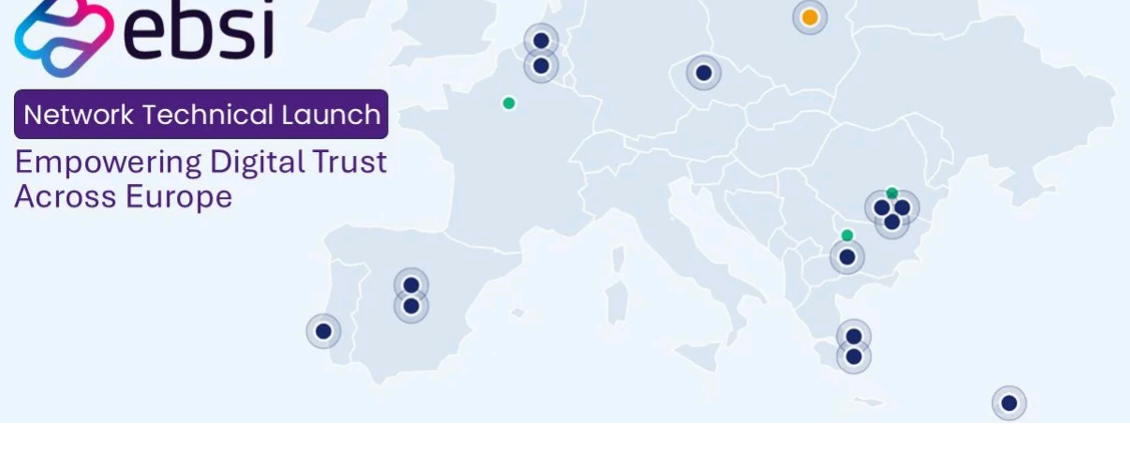

A New Milestone: EBSI Production Network is Live

On 15 April 2026, Europeum-EDIC completed the **technical launch** of the EBSI production environment. The network currently runs on **20 nodes** operated in **11 countries** and will continue to grow.

As part of the technical launch, Europeum made **two public tools** available to make the **network visible and accessible** to anyone:

A real-time view of all active nodes across the production environment.

FROM THE COMMUNITY

How can web3 support European creativity?



On 22 April 2026, the European Commission and EBSI concluded the **2025 Copyright Innovation Challenge**, a six-month open innovation programme that invited startups, developers, and researchers to **design verifiable, decentralised copyright solutions**.

Three pilots showed working solutions across the copyright lifecycle:

Allfeat

Providing persistent artist identity and control over creative works.

i2cat^R

Improving visibility and tracking of music usage and revenues.

SPHERITY

Enabling trusted, verifiable copyright through a Digital Copyright Passport.

Three roundtables highlighted a common message. The main challenges standing between pilots and real deployment:

- Reliable creator identification and high-quality metadata
- Shared standards and interoperable systems
- Trust across the value chain as a central requirement

Next steps: the European Commission will publish a challenge report, launch an EU-wide awareness initiative, and run workshops with Member States through the Copyrights Infrastructure Task Force.

Europeum at EBRA Malta 2026

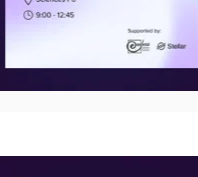
On 27 May, Xavier Juredieu spoke as a panellist at the EBRA Annual Conference in Malta, joining the session **"From Authentic Source to Trusted Wallet"** on how **Business Registries power the EUDI Wallet** ecosystem. EBRA announced the establishment of a dedicated task force to **monitor ongoing EU regulatory developments**, and the panel reaffirmed the strategic role of **Business Registries as authentic sources of verified identity**. Xavier also shared **Europeum's readiness to support eIDAS 2.0** implementation for Wallets.
